In order to make the tournament run as smooth as possible, I have put together this coaches packet for you. It contains important information that you may need throughout the weekend. Also, please remember the following:

1. Each team is responsible for their own book. There will be copies of score sheets just in case you forget your book.
2. Please arrive at least 20 minutes early for your game. If both teams are there and we have a chance to start a few minutes early, it will help keep all the games on schedule.
3. There will be concessions stands at each location with Gatorade, etc. available. Millbrook High School does not allow food or drinks into the gym. At all locations, PLEASE make sure your kids pick up after themselves and put all empty water and gatorade bottles in the trash. Also, if it is a nice day and teams are outside in between games, please ask them to keep the grounds clean.
4. There is a \$5 admission fee for spectators. Each spectator will be issued a wrist band for that day. Please ask your fans to where display their bands at all times. Children under age 5 will be admitted free. There will also be a weekend pass available for \$8.

## Get an Edge IX Tournament Rules

1. Game Timing: Two 20-minute halves with a running clock. The last two-minutes of each half, the clock shall stop on all dead ball situations. Only the tournament director has the option of changing the time for warm up and half time to get games caught up. If there is more than a twenty-five point spread in a game both coaches must agree to waive the stop clock during the last two minutes. Overtime: There will be a 2-minute overtime in all games ending in a tie, with each team receiving one time out for the overtime (Teams may not carry-over any timeouts). The clock will stop for all dead ball situations during overtime. Double Overtime: Games will be decided by sudden death, meaning the team who scores the first point (does not have to be a basket, it can be a free throw) will have won the game. Again, teams will be awarded one time out with no carry-overs. Overtime at Nationals: At all AYBT National Tournaments, only for the single elimination tournament, there will be no sudden death overtimes. There will be a 2-minute overtime until a winner is decided.

2. Fouls: Each player is allowed 5, shooting one and one on the 7th team foul, double bonus (two shots) on the 10th team foul. Technical Fouls: will not be shot, 2 points will be awarded to the other team. A second technical foul by the same individual and that individual is removed from the gym. The individual will receive a one game suspension for their next schedule game. (A next scheduled game would be at the event or national that the individual is currently participating or it could be the next DSE or National the individual participates).

3. Time-Outs: Each team has two 30-second time-outs per half, with no carry-overs. Overtime Time Outs: Each team is given one time out for every overtime, no carry-overs.

3. Turn left at New Hackensack Rd/NY-376 0.3 mi
4. Slight right toward NY-376/Raymond Ave 0.1 mi
5. Slight right at NY-376/Raymond Ave 0.3 mi
6. At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit and stay on NY-376/Raymond Ave 0.2 mi
7. At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit and stay on NY-376/Raymond Ave 0.4 mi
8. Turn right at Haight Ave/NY-55/US-44 Continue to follow US-44 11.2mi
9. Continue on NY-82/Rte-82 1.9 mi
10. Turn left at Franklin Ave 0.8 mi
11. Turn right at Church St 0.2 mi
12. Turn left at Alden Pl Destination will be on the right 0.3 mi

4. Turn right at NY-82/Rte-82 Continue to follow NY-82 2.9 mi
5. Continue on Rte-44/US-44 Continue to follow US-44 10.1mi
6. Turn left at NY-376/Van Wagner Rd Continue to follow NY-376 0.6 mi
7. At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto NY-376/Raymond Ave 0.2 mi
8. At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit and stay on NY-376/Raymond Ave 0.4 mi
9. Turn left at Hooker Ave/NY-376 Continue to follow NY-376 0.4 mi
10. Turn right at Boardman Rd Destination will be on the left 1.5 mi
