

SAFETY IS OUR #1 PRIORITY, PLEASE READ THROUGH ALL ITEMS BELOW BEFORE ENTERING INSPORTS FOR PROGRAMMING!

Insports is excited to be able to bring your children back into our facility for competitive activity as well as practices and training. Safety is our #1 priority and we need your help with compliance of our policies and procedures in order to continue to offer programming during this time. Please note that if we find participants and/or parents not complying with our detailed procedures, we may decide that allowing spectators for games or league play (parents/guardians) is not conducive to a safe environment for our customers. This means that our policies and procedures are subject to change at any point based on constant evaluation of operations by Insports management. If individuals do not follow our rules and requirements, they will be asked to leave the facility.

FACILITY POLICIES & PROCEDURES:

- Insports will be allowing 1 spectator (parent/guardian) per child for any competitive games or league play. Spectators will not be permitted to bring along additional children, infants, or grandparents.
- Insports <u>will not</u> be allowing any spectators (parent/guardian) for rentals, practices, clinics, or traditional non-competitive youth programming.
- If you are here to spectate a game, please abide by social distancing guidelines and make sure you are always wearing your mask, covering both your nose and mouth.
- Please frequently utilize our 8 hand sanitizing stations throughout the facility as well as our 2 stand-alone hand washing stations or bathroom sinks to keep yourself clean and sanitized.
- Please cooperate with our staff, referees, and coaches as we continue to regulate our programming in order to provide a safe environment for your children to continue development in their sport(s).

CHECK-IN:

- Parents and children are REQUIRED to check-in on their <u>mobile device</u> prior to arriving at Insports.

 - Type the parents first and last name when originally prompted. The program will
 then ask "If you are checking in children for any programming today, please
 indicate all names below. (One check-in is sufficient)" This will cover the checkin for both the parent as well as the children that are being checked in.
